



The California Energy Commission Electric Program Investment Charge Program -- \$22M Grant Funding Opportunity for Microgrids -- Application Submission Closing Date 20 October 2017

The California Energy Commission (CEC) Electric Program Investment Charge (EPIC) Program has released Grant Funding Opportunity (GFO) GFO-17-302 to Demonstrate Business Case for Advanced Microgrids in Support of California's Energy and GHG Policies <http://www.energy.ca.gov/contracts/epic.html#GFO-17-302>. The GFO-17-302 expressly identifies California Military Bases as a focus area and has allocated \$22M towards the effort. Application submissions close on October 20th, 2017.

The U.S. Army has installations located in the service territories of the three eligible California Investor Owned Utilities (IOUs), including Presidio of Monterey and Fort Irwin, which currently have distributed energy resources. The U.S. Army would cooperate to the extent permissible by law with any grant recipient whose project is considered to be in the best interest of the U. S. Army.
