

# Intergovernmental Support Agreements

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- FY 13 NDAA Section 331 (codified in 10 USC 2336) authorized the Military Services to enter into Intergovernmental Support Agreements for installation support services

## Key Highlights:

- Military Services may provide, receive or share services with local or State governments if in the best interests of the Department (e.g., increase efficiency/lower cost)
  - Ability to sole-source to public entities
  - May use wage grades normally paid by public entities
  - Partnership agreements not to exceed 5 years
- **OSD Acquisition Community determined only a FAR contract could be used as a transaction instrument for IGSA's to acquire services**
- **NDAA 15 HASC marks indicate clarification to allow other instruments**

- **IGSA EXORD resulted in a very limited response from the field (Oct 13)**
  - Furloughs and year-end closeout actions
  - FY14 shut down
  - Budget impacts and vacancies
- **ACSIM-ISP responded strategically by facilitating Army-Community Partnership meetings to jump-start partnership discussions**
- **Increased response has been a direct result of these engagements**
- **ASA (IE&E) was delegated authority to approve IGSA's in May 2014**



## Next Steps

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- **Concept Approval Executive Meetings**
- **Issue initial FRAGO to OACSIM EXORD**
  - **Provide lessons learned and updated approval process**
  - **Reflect anticipated legislation change per Committee mark-ups**
  - **Re-emphasize requirement for submission of all existing agreements**
- **Provide stakeholders a range of options for transaction instruments—FAR contract, IGSA, MOU/MOA, etc.**
- **Complete stand-up of IGSA page on OACSIM public website (Fall 2014)**
  - **Codify templates and place on the web**
  - **Allow communities to review concepts**
- **Facilitate development of concepts into partnership agreements**
- **Continue strategic communications for the program**
